UNAPPROVED MINUTES: The Hamlin County Board of Commissioners met on June 21 with the following members present Noem, Saathoff, Rudebusch and Roe. Absent: Baldwin. John Delzer States Attorney also present.

The Chairman led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

AGENDA: Motion by Saathoff seconded by Rudebusch to approve the agenda as posted. All members voting Aye. Motion Carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Rudebusch seconded by Roe to approve the minutes of June 7 All members voting Aye. Motion Carried.

HIGHWAY DEPT: Bryan Pedersen Highway Supt met with the Board. Striping on 446th Ave complete and project is a FEMA project sent to the State for reimbursement. Mat overlay by Castlewood is done. The Dept will be putting gravel on the intersections and approaches. He has been getting quotes for the patrol shed in Castlewood that was damaged. The insurance company will only replace damaged tin not the tin on the whole building. Basin will start putting the second lift of gravel on the Vienna Road. Nothing heard yet from the railroad for the overhead bridge removal.

AUTOMATIC SUPPLEMENT: Motion by Rudebusch seconded by Roe to make an automatic supplement to the Road revenue budget in the amount of \$708.40 (201-374.10) for sale of scrap iron. All members voting Aye. Motion Carried.

COURT ROOM SOUND SYSTEM: The state court system had requested the sound system be replaced in the court room at the cost of \$22,532.46 Motion by Roe seconded by Rudebusch to leave sound system as is which seems to be working alright. All members voting aye. Motion Carried.

REGISTER OF DEEDS: Amber Raasch Register of Deeds met with the Board. Her deputy had retired at the end of May. She had advertised with no results. She was wondering if this could become a full-time position or have benefits. The Board stated this could be possible if needed.

CASTLEWOOD CITY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT: Motion by Saathoff seconded by Rudebusch to authorize the Chairman to sign the Shared Law Enforcement Agreement with Castlewood City for Jan.1-2023-Dec. 31-2023 in the amount of \$4,008.33 per month and \$558.64 each quarter for non-emergency calls received by Watertown Dispatch. All members voting Aye. Motion Carried. Castlewood City had already signed such.

FIRST DISTRICT CONTRACT: Motion by Roe seconded by Saathoff to authorize the Chairman to sign the Resolution to Continue Support for the First District Assoc. from Oct 1st, 2022 - Sept 30th, 2023 in the amount of \$15,320.00 All members voting Aye. Motion Carried.
